1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.74 dated 14.04.2021 registered under Sections 306 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, submits that the petitioner, who is sister-in-law of the deceased-Sandeep Kaur, is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. She submits that although, the petitioner was named in the FIR, however, during investigation it was found that at the time of incident, the petitioner was in the office of Ramesh Kumar Grover, Architect and was not at home, therefore, the challan/final report under Section 173 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 has been filed against the brother of the petitioner namely Amrik Singh (husband of deceased-Sandeep Kaur), who has already been granted the concession of regular bail, vide

order dated 03.09.2021, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala. She further submits that the petitioner has now been summoned to face trial under Section 306 read with Section 34 of IPC as an additional accused. She further submits that the petitioner is ready to appear before the Trial Court and she may be protected.

3. Learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paperbook.

5. Considering overall facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the Trial Court on 31.07.2025 i.e. the date already fixed before it and on her doing so, she shall be released on bail on furnishing of bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.
