DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

1. By way of the present petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner prays for setting aside the order dated 07.08.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jagadhri in CS-1771-2017 titled Naresh Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and others, whereby the evidence of the plaintiff (petitioner herein) was closed by the Trial Court.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner-plaintiff does not wish to examine any witness, but seeks an opportunity only to tender in evidence the relevant revenue documents, as the case primarily depends upon revenue entries.

3. After perusal of the record, it is evident that the petitioner had already availed several opportunities before his evidence was closed by the trial Court. However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner now only seeks to tender revenue documents in evidence, trial Court is directed to



grant one opportunity to the petitioner to do so, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to contesting respondents No.1 to 3. The said cost shall be paid by way of a demand draft on the date to be fixed by the trial Court for production of the aforesaid documentary evidence.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
