Prayer in the instant revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is for setting aside the order dated 05.01.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division) Dasuya, whereby the objections filed by the petitioner were dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the last date of hearing i.e. 28.11.2023, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court wherein the matter stands settled between the parties by way of Settlement/Agreement dated 15.01.2024. It is submitted that as per the agreement, the parties have agreed that fresh demarcation of land in dispute be carried out after appointment of a Local Commissioner. It is accordingly, prayed that nothing survives in the present revision petition and the same may be disposed of, as such.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 has not disputed the aforesaid submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant revision petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
