1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that as per the Advertisement dated 02.01.2025 (Annexure P-2) issued by the Punjab Public Service Commission though, a candidate is required to possess the Bachelors degree in any discipline from any recognized University or Institution in order to appear in the competitive exams but the candidate can appear in the said examination before the award of the said degree on the condition that he/she can pass the said Bachelors degree before taking the mains competitive exams hence, it is the prayer of the petitioner that he be allowed to appear in the said examination as has been advertised subject to the production of the Bachelor degree in case he clears the preliminary examination and becomes entitled to take the main examination.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to approach the Punjab Public Service Commission for allowing him to appear in the examination as has been advertised by filing an appropriate representation and the Punjab Public Service Commission may kindly be

directed to decide the said representation so that the petitioner can avail the chance to appear in examination in pursuance to the Advertisement dated 02.01.2025 (Annexure P-2).

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, learned Sr. Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation/claim is filed by the petitioner claiming any relief, the same will be considered by the competent authority in accordance with law and appropriate order on the said representation/claim will be passed by the competent authority within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of any such claim/representation and in case, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will be granted to him otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner, which reasons will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent-Punjab Public Service Commission by filing appropriate representation.

7. Ordered accordingly.
