1. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr. Shashi Gagg, Assistant Registrar (Legal), submits that in compliance of the order passed by the Writ Court, the arrears/consequential relief in terms of refixation of salary of the petitioner shall be released within a period of 04 weeks from today.

2. In view of the above, learned counsel for petitioners submits that he does not want to press the present petition.

3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

4. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
