1. Present revision petition is directed against order dated 19.09.2025 (Annexure P-7).
2. The petitioner is a judgment debtor in an ex-parte decree. He has moved an application under Order IX Rule 13 CPC praying for setting aside of the ex-parte decree. In the parallel execution proceedings based upon the ex-parte decree, present application was moved which stands declined vide impugned order.
3. After hearing counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the records, this Court does not find any reason to interfere in the impugned order. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an appropriate application in the proceedings arising out of Order IX Rule 13 CPC.
4. In view of above, the present revision petition is disposed off.



5. It is made clear that nothing expressed hereinabove shall be construed as an expression on the merits of the case including maintainability of the application.

6. Since the main case has been decided, pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed off.
