1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.124, dated 29.04.2023, under Section 22,25 (29 of N.D.P.S Act added later on), registered at Police Station STF, STF Wing, SAS Nagar, Mohali.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 23.09.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. A status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Anti Narcotics Task Force, Border, Range, Amritsar has been filed on behalf of respondent-State and the same is taken on record.
4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the

parties, the interim order dated 23.09.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S/438(2) of Cr.P.C.
