**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner was seeking release of retiral dues as well as direction to respondent to conclude pending vigilance inquiry in a time bound manner.

2. Mr. Shivam Bansal, Advocate submits that respondent by order dated 30.01.2025 has determined liability of deceased employee to the tune of ₹8,70,000/-. There is no other inquiry which is pending against him. Thus, petitioner is entitled to release all retiral dues except ₹8,70,000/.

3. Ms. Madhu Dayal, Advocate submits that she has no information about the status of second inquiry initiated by Vigilance Department.

4. Be that as it may, the respondent No. 1 is directed to release retiral dues of deceased employee along with interest @ 6% per annum after retaining

₹8,70,000/- as determined vide order dated 30.01.2025. The respondents are further at liberty to retain any other amount that may have been determined in any other inquiry pending or decided against the deceased employee-petitioner.

5. Let the needful be done within one month from today.
