Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a *mandamus* upon the respondents-distribution licensee to install a high voltage transformer at the designated public place in the petitioners' village without any further delay and not to change already demarcated place as shown in the site plan (Annexure P-1).

2. Today, learned counsel appearing for respondents no.7 and 8-distribution licensee, informs this Court that the installation of high voltage transformer is underway and the same will be completed within a period of 15 days from today.

3. In view of the above, no further direction is required to be passed in the instant petition. Consequently, the instant petition is ordered to be **closed**.
