HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. Learned State counsel representing the respondents informs that upon completion of formalities by the petitioner, the claim with respect to benefit of LTC payable to him shall be considered within two weeks from today and in case he is found entitled, the same shall be released within two weeks thereafter.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
4. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
