Today, petitioner is present in person who explained that the matter was compromised with the intervention of respectables but later-on it was realized that terms alleged by other side with the assistance of their Advocates were not justified. Therefore, she refused to effect compromise on those terms and conditions.

Even today dispute still exists, and she is residing in her parental house.

At this stage, in view of the status report, learned counsel for petitioner states that petitioner is ready to file fresh representation by disclosing all the facts therein and that may be considered by the official respondent Nos.3 and 4 in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel representing State assured that representation given by petitioner will be disposed of expeditiously.

In view of the aforesaid factual position, present petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to file fresh representation within a period of one week and the same be disposed of by official respondent Nos.3 and 4 within a period of six weeks and the petitioner will cooperate with the Investigating Agency as and when required to appear, as per law.

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
