Present revision petition has been filed assailing the impugned order dated 23.02.2024, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar, whereby, appeal against the order dated 05.02.2024, of learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Hisar, declining the bail to petitioner in FIR No.169 dated 26.02.2023, under Section 186, 332, 353, 307 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sadar, Hisar, was dismissed.
