1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 25.07.2023 passed in CWP-5612-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Dr. Manoj Kumar, Ayurvedic Medical Officer, Nuh (Mewat), filed in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 25.07.2023 passed in CWP-5612-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 07.02.2024 has been passed and necessary payment has been made to the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
