AMARINDER SINGH GREWAL, J.

1. Prayer in the present Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is for setting aside the impugned order dated 29.05.2025 (Annexure P-3), passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), District Charkhi Dadri, in Civil Suit No. CS-1161-2022, titled as *Virender vs. Mahabir Parshad and another*, whereby the defence of the petitioner-defendant No. 1 was struck off.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the defence of the petitioner-defendant No. 1 was struck off, vide order dated 29.05.2025 (Annexure P-3), the valuable rights of the petitioner-defendant No. 1 are involved in the suit.

2.1 It is further submitted that only one opportunity may be granted to the petitioner-defendant No. 1 for filing the written statement before the learned lower court. He informs that the next date of hearing before the lower court is 18.12.2025.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the revisionist-petitioner and perused the paper-book.

4. In view of the order proposed to be passed, notice is not being issued to the contesting respondent No. 1-plaintiff, as it would delay the proceedings besides entailing additional expense to the contesting respondent No. 1-plaintiff.

5. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, and in the interest of justice, the present petition is allowed. One opportunity is granted to the petitioner-defendant No. 1 for filing the written statement before the learned lower court. The petitioner-defendant No. 1 is directed to appear before the learned lower court, which shall grant one effective opportunity for filing the written statement, subject to payment of costs of ₹5,000/- to the contesting respondent No. 1-plaintiff.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
