AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Reply by way of short affidavit of Balbir Singh, Director of Public Instruction (Secondary Education), Punjab, filed in Court which is taken on record. As per the said reply, petitioner No.2 has been promoted as Headmaster and thus, contempt petition qua said petitioner has been rendered infructuous.

I have considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the judgment passed by the Supreme Court which clearly states that 3% of the cadre strength is to be reserved for the disabled persons and on computing the said quota, the claim of petitioner No.1 has been considered as per the cadre strength and the quota having been accomplished, petitioner No.1 could not be promoted.

In view of the above, the contempt petition against the respondents does not survive and the same, therefore, stands dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
