1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to pay the compensation to the petitioner for his bore installed in his land, which was used in flooded condition by the Govt., without paying any compensation.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has made the representation/application dated 10.01.2023 (Annexure P-2), to the Sub-Divisional Officer, Fatehabad. However, neither his representation/application (supra) has been decided, nor he has been given any compensation, as asked for, which propelled him to file the instant petition, seeking mandamus upon the competent respondent amongst the respondents, to take apt steps.

3. At this stage, without assessing the merits of the instant case, and the entitlement of the petitioner, this Court deems it fit and appropriate, at the

first instance, to pass a mandamus upon the competent respondent amongst the respondents, to decide the representation/application dated 10.01.2023 (Annexure P-2), by passing a speaking order, after providing due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

4. The exercise (supra), shall be carried out within 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order/judgment.

5. **Disposed of** accordingly.
