1. On 21.04.2025, following order was passed:-

“Present petition has been filed by the petitioner-Harjinder Kumar, aged 31 years, seeking an appropriate direction to Inspector General of Police, Ambala (respondent No.2) to transfer the investigation in FIR No.124 dated 26.07.2024 under Sections 140(2) and 61 of BNSS 2023 registered at Police Station Nggal, District Ambala to any other independent agency.

Allegation of the petitioner is that despite the registration of FIR more than 08 months back, neither the investigation has been completed nor the accused have been arrested. He admits that the dispute, in fact, is matrimonial in nature with the private respondents.

Mr. Kanwar Sanjiv Kumar, AAG, Haryana while appearing on advance notice on instructions from SI Dharampal informs that after completing the investigation, cancellation report has been prepared and presently it is before respondent No.3 (Superintendent of Police, Ambala) who has to take a final call on that.

Meanwhile, final decision would be taken by respondent No.3 in regard to the preparation of cancellation report.”

2. Learned State counsel has filed status report dated 17.05.2025 in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

3. As per paragraph No. 14 of the status report, cancellation report was prepared on 30.01.2025 and subsequently approved by the senior police officials on 09.05.2025. Thereafter, the said cancellation report was submitted before the Court of the Area Magistrate. In the course of proceedings, the statement of the complainant, Harjinder Kumar, was recorded by the Court. The matter now stands adjourned for 09.10.2025 for further proceedings.

4. For reference, paragraph No.14 of the status report says as under:-

“4. That on dated 28.01.2025, both the parties were again summoned in the police station and facts of the case were verified by SHO PS Naggal, on the basis of the facts and circumstances of the case, on the basis of the scientific /oral evidence collected or came on the file so far and statements of the witnesses recorded in the present case, the allegations levelled in the present case could not be proved on the case file, hence on dated 30.01.2025, cancellation report has been prepared in the present matter and presented before the higher police officials for taking final decision upon the same. It is submitted that on dated after due approval of the senior police officials, on dated 09.05.2025, the complainant alongwith the cancellation report has been produced before the Ld. Court of Illaqa Magistrate, and the Ld. Court was pleased to register the same vide UCR/764/2025 titled as State of Haryana THROUGH HARJINDER KUMAR Versus UNKNOWN dated 09.05.2025 wherein, the Ld. Court of JMICA/Ambala after recording the statement of complainant-Harjinder Kumar was pleased to adjourn the case further for 09.10.2025.”

5. In view of the fact that the issue regarding cancellation and its finalisation is presently pending consideration before the Court of the Area Magistrate, this Court does not find any substantial reason to continue with the present petition. At this stage, no directions are required to be issued. Accordingly, present petition stands **disposed of**.
