The applicant-wife has filed the present application for seeking transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act i.e. HMA/1813/2023, titled '*Mahipal Bajwan Vs. Rama*', filed by the respondent-husband, pending in the Family Court, Faridabad and she seeks transfer of the same to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Naraingarh, District Ambala.

In pursuance of the notice issued, respondent made appearance through counsel. The counsel for the respondent submits that he does not intend to file reply and further, he has no objection if the transfer application is allowed.

Heard.

It is submitted by the counsel for the applicant that the marriage between the parties to the lis, had taken place on 24.11.2016. Two children were born from the said wedlock, who are about 6 years old and 4 years old



and they are in the care and custody of the applicant. As per the version given in the application, the applicant has no independent source of income. The distance between Faridabad and Naraingarh is about 285 kilometres. Also, there are three other cases pending in the Courts at Naraingarh, which have arisen out of this matrimonial dispute, the detail whereof has been given in paragraph No.1 of the application.

In view of the aforesaid fact situation, more particularly considering the statement made by the counsel for the respondent, the transfer application is allowed and the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act i.e. HMA/1813/2023, titled '*Mahipal Bajwan Vs. Rama*', filed by the respondent-husband, stands transferred from the Family Court, Faridabad, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Naraingarh, District Ambala. The requisite record of the aforesaid case be sent by the Family Court, Faridabad, to the District and Sessions Judge, Ambala.

Learned District and Sessions Judge, Ambala, shall assign the said petition to the Family Court (Camp Court) Naraingarh. Even, the parties are directed to appear before the Family Court (Camp Court) Naraingarh, within a period of one month from today onwards.
