Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent for not complying the order dated 07.9.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-20221-2022 titled as “Ashok Garg vs. State of Haryana and others”, vide which the writ petition was disposed of with a direction “....to respondent No.4 to decide the pending representation dated 10.8.2022 (Annexure P-8) by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Compliance report dated 04.3.2024 by way of affidavit of Smt. Suman Lata, Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Sohna



has already been filed in the Registry, which is annexed on the file. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing an order dated 12.1.2024 (Annexure R-1 annexed with the Compliance Report) by the respondent-authority; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the order dated 07.9.2022 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with and an order dated 12.1.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed by the respondent-authority, the present contempt petition may be disposed of.

Heard.

In view of the facts noted above and the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present contempt petition is **disposed of** accordingly.

Rule stands discharged.
