1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) 2023 for quashing the charge sheet dated 07.12.2023 and FIR No. 434 dated 10.07.2023 registered under Sections 506/509/34 (Section 180 of IPC added lateron) at Police Station, Shivaji Colony, District Rohtak, Haryana and all other subsequent proceedings arising out it against the petitioners in the present case.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the above case and the present case is based on false and fabricated story. No offence has been made out against the petitioners. There is no evidence on record to prove direct involvement of petitioner No. 2 in the present case. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner No. 2 is now married to Rashi and have a child. He was having affair with the daughter of the complainant.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the whole records of the case.



4. A perusal of the record shows that in the present case, challan has already been presented and in the FIR, there are serious allegations against the present petitioner.
5. In view of the above, this Court do not find any ground to quash the charge sheet dated 07.12.2023 and FIR No. 434 dated 10.07.2023 registered under Sections 506/509/34 (Section 180 of IPC added lateron) at Police Station, Shivaji Colony, District Rohtak, Haryana and all other subsequent proceedings arising out it against the petitioners in the present case.
6. The petition, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.
7. Pending application (s), if any, also stand disposed of.
