Power of Attorney on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed today in Court in favour of Mr.Sandeep Kumar Yadav, Advocate, which is taken on the record.

On 11.08.2025, on behalf of the appellant statement was made to accept ₹9,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of the Insurance Company concurrence has been given to this effect. Thus, a sum of ₹9,00,000/- (₹ Nine Lakh Only) is allowed to the appellant against the Insurance Company.

It has been stated by learned counsel for the appellant that inadvertently, in the Memo of Parties, father name of the appellant has been mentioned as "Ashraf" i.e. "Sammedin @ Samay Deen son of Ashraf", whereas in the claim petition, father name of the appellant has been mentioned as "Ahmed" i.e. "Sammedin son of Ahmed". He has further stated that even in the Aadhar Card, name of the appellant has been mentioned as "Samay Deen son of Ahmad". Hence, he requests that cheque be issued in the name of "Samay Deen son of Ahmad".

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Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹9,00,000/- in the name of the appellant - Samay Deen son of Ahmad with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 29.09.2025, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
