By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
94	01.09.2024	118 (1) of BNS, 2023	Bahav Wala, District Fazilka.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 23.01.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 23.01.2025.

3. Learned State counsel intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

4. During the course of hearing on 23.01.2025, following order was passed:

“ Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the



petitioner is falsely nominated as accused in the present case and even otherwise also as per the medical record Annexure P-2 and Annexure P-3, the injuries alleged to be caused by the present petitioner are found to be simple in nature. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner is ready and willing to join investigation with the police.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Pargat Singh submits that petitioner is specifically named in the FIR and the injuries attributed to him are also specifically described in the FIR and he is required by the police for proper investigation of the case. However, the State counsel has not disputed the fact that injuries caused by the petitioner are found to be simple in nature.

Now be listed on 06.05.2025.

In light of the above, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation with the police and in case of arrest, he is directed to be released on interim bail by the IO/Arresting Officer to his own satisfaction till the next date of hearing. The petitioner is to abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 23.01.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 23.01.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will

influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
