1. This is the 4th petition filed by the petitioner under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short "B.N.S.S.") for grant of regular bail in:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
02	01.01.2020	Jhabal, District Tarn Taran	21, 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959

2. Version of the prosecution is that an Innova vehicle was intercepted with five occupants. Sarabjit Singh was driving the vehicle and Jasbir Singh @ Lama (present petitioner) was sitting on the adjoining seat. The other three occupants of the vehicle were Sagar, Chand Singh and Vikas. Recovery of 720 grams of heroin and a pistol has been made from the occupants of the vehicle.

3. State counsel has filed custody certificate dated 01.02.2025 and has opposed the petition by submitting that the petitioner is a history-sheeter. He has specific instructions to state that recovery of 263 grams heroin has been effected from the petitioner. As per his instructions, prosecution has concluded its evidence and after recording of statement of the accused under Section 313, Cr.P.C., trial is fixed for defence evidence.

4. After addressing for sometime, counsel for the petitioner seeks permission for withdrawal of the petition.

5. Permission is granted.

6. Dismissed as withdrawn.
