The present petition has been filed for seeking directions to the respondents to grant the petitioners Rs. 10,000/- allowance for staying in the District Nuh Mewat as per Notification dated 17.04.2021 (Annexure P-3) issued by Govt. of Haryana.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that the petitioners are posted as Guest Teachers in Schools situated in District Nuh, Mewat and have been working as such since the date of their appointment. He further submits that respondents issued a notification dated 17.04.2021 whereby an allowance to the tune of Rs. 10,000/- per month has been directed to be paid to the employees for staying in District Nuh, Mewat. However, no such

allowance has been paid to the petitioners till date whereas other similarly situated Guest Teachers are being paid the said allowance.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and to file reply, if any.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.2-Director, Elementary Education, Shiksha Sadan, Panchkula is directed to treat the present petition as a representation and decide the same in time bound manner.

Learned State counsel does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.2 to treat the present petition as a representation and decide the same by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the representation, if the petitioners are found eligible for the claim raised herein, the entire dues shall be calculated and released in favour of the petitioners within a further period of two months, failing which the

respondent shall be liable to pay a cost of **Rs. 50,000/-** with the “**Poor Patients Welfare Fund**’ of the **Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh**”, which shall be recoverable from the concerned erring Officer/official.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
