1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.PC seeking direction to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation and take legal action against the accused persons as they have committed murder of the son of the petitioner.

2. Learned State counsel while referring to the reply dated 24.09.2022 submits that the present petition has been filed after a gap of two years from the death of the son of the petitioner. The dispute is with regard to the *ex-gratia* amount between the petitioner and his daughter-in-law. Further there is dispute with regard to the money lying in the bank account of the deceased son of the petitioner and due to the monetary dispute between the parties, the present petition has been filed.

He further submits that the petitioner remained mum for more than 02 years and she has also not come forward to join the investigation even after filing of the present petition. At the time of the incident, the statements of

all concerned were recorded and the proceedings under Section 174 Cr.PC were initiated wherein no foul play was pointed out.

3. Accordingly, keeping in view the above fact, the present petition stands dismissed.
