1. Prayer made in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to pass an order of retirement of the petitioner on 30.04.2021 and grant of all retiral benefits.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has served a legal notice (Annexure P-8) upon the respondents but the same is pending consideration. At this stage, on instructions from the petitioner, he prays that a direction may be given to respondent No.4 to decide the same in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.

In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the legal notice (Annexure P-8), within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law. In the event, the claim/grievance of the petitioner is declined, the respondent No.4 shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner.
