The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No.4 to 13 and take necessary legal action against them.

2. In the context of threat perception, the petitioners have moved representation dated 16.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2 (Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran), wherein, the apprehension to their life and liberty has been expressed; however, it is stated that no action has been taken.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied at this stage, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 (Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran) to consider/decide their representation dated 16.05.2025 (Annexure P-2).

4. At this stage, Mr. Nirmaljit Singh Diwana, Sr. DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of the respondent(s)-State of Punjab pursuant to the advance copy of the petition having been sent to the State of Punjab and submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioners as regards apprehensions to their lives & liberty shall be looked into by the respondent authorities.

5. In view of above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in the representation, respondent No.2 (Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran); is directed to look into the representation dated 16.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) only *qua* threat perception to the lives and liberty of petitioners, if any, and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law.

6. It is made clear that this order shall also not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

7. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.

8. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
