KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner made statement that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take all the pleas taken in the present petition before the Court concerned at the appropriate stage of trial. He further made request that the personal appearance of the petitioner Pinky before the trial Court be exempted taking into consideration the fact that she is 27 years of age and is mother of 2 minor children aged about 3/4 years and it is not practically possible for the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing. He further stated that even on the last date of hearing, this Court granted said exemption to the petitioner till the next date of hearing fixed in the present petition.

2. The prayer with regard to withdrawal of the present petition is not opposed by the State counsel.

3. In light of the above, the present petition is hereby disposed of



being withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to take all the pleas taken in the present petition before the learned trial Court at the proper stage of trial with further liberty to the petitioner to move an application before the trial Court seeking her permanent exemption from appearing in the trial proceedings. In case, any such application is filed by the petitioner, the same is to be disposed of by the learned trial Court in accordance with law by taking sympathetic view, in the light of the fact that petitioner is a house wife aged about 27 years having 2 minor children aged about 3/4 years.
