Learned counsel for the petitioner-company submits that the respondent-Employees Provident Fund Organization issued a show cause notice dated 15.01.2024 (Annexure P/2) to the petitioner-company for the payment of certain dues towards the provident fund of the employees working with the petitioner-company and said show cause notice has already been reported back by the petitioner-company by taking certain pleas while serving legal notice dated 25.02.2025 (Annexures P/8) upon the respondents, which is still pending consideration with the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner-company further submits that the respondents are under an obligation to take into consideration the averments mentioned in the legal notice dated 25.02.2025 (Annexures P/8) while deciding the liability of the petitioner-company under the show cause notice issued, which is not being done by the respondents.
