1. Prayer made in the present petition is for quashing the order dated 05.05.1995 with regard to the condition No.3 mentioned in it.
2. Learned State counsel refers to preliminary objection No.1, to state that as a matter of fact as per Rules mentioned therein, Study Leave could only be granted after 5 years of service, while petitioner had merely 2 years to her credit, still vide the impugned order application of the petitioner for admission to B.Sc. (Post Basic Nursing) Course for the Session 1995-97, was forwarded to the PGI albeit with the impugned condition that she would not claim any financial benefit or promotion in service, on account of having done the said Course. This was categorically accepted by her by filing an affidavit, attested by the Executive Magistrate on 12.07.1995 (Annexure P2). However, after completion of said course and that too in the year 2003, challenge has been made.
3. Disposed of, reserving the petitioner with a liberty to get it revived, in case need arises.
