1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.61 dated 26.09.2024 registered under Sections 498-A & 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.
