1. Challenge in the present appeal is to the judgment and decree dated 04.01.2018 passed by the 1st Appellate Court, vide which the judgment and decree dated 08.01.2015 has been set aside.

2. Learned counsel for the appellants as well as learned counsel appearing for the contesting respondents have jointly submitted that the present case has been compromised and in pursuance of the said compromise, respondents No.1 to 3 have paid an amount of Rs.22,00,000/- (Rs.20,00,000/- by way of a demand draft + Rs.2,00,000/-

in cash) to the appellants/plaintiffs in the presence of learned counsel for the appellants. It is further jointly submitted that after receiving the said amount, the present appellants have no right in the suit property and they are satisfied with the judgment passed by the 1st Appellate Court dated 04.01.2018.

3. Learned counsel for the appellants has submitted that in view of the above-said compromise, the appellants be permitted to withdraw the present appeal.

4. In view of the above, the present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for.

5. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of in view of the above-said order.
