1. The present appeal has been filed challenging the order passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Jhajjar, on 16.07.2024.
2. The appellant herein is the respondent's husband. He has filed a petition under Section 28-A of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, for enforcement of award passed by the Permanent and Continuous Lok Adalat, Jhajjar, on 28.03.2009. As per the aforesaid award, the parties entered into a settlement and the divorce petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, was disposed of accordingly. The appellant had filed a subsequent petition for grant of decree of divorce against the wife, which was dismissed on 24.05.2011. Subsequently, the judgment of the Family Court was upheld on 12.03.2013 by the First Appellate Court. Ultimately, SLP filed by the appellant was also dismissed on 20.02.2017.
3. Additionally, the appellant has failed to pay Rs.5,50,000/-



towards arrears of maintenance as noticed in para 36 of the order passed on 16.07.2024 by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Jhajjar. Hence, no ground to interfere in the order dated 16.07.2024 is made out.

3. The present appeal, thus, is dismissed.

4. Since the appeal has been dismissed on merits, hence, no order is required to be passed in the application for condonation of delay.
