1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 05.12.2023 passed in CWP-26603-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 05.12.2023 passed in CWP-26603-2023 has since been complied with and legal notice of the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order dated 01.02.2024 (Annexure R-1). After calculating the arrears, an amount of Rs.3,23,207/- has been deposited in the account of the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
