1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 18.05.2021 in CWP No. 9905 of 2021.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P-1 dated 18.05.2021 reveals that CWP No.9905 of 2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the complaints in accordance with law expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in the instant petition.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to filing of the instant petition, the respondent has decided the complaints filed by the petitioner and the petitioner has challenged decision in respect of the same by way of CWP No.26482 of 2021, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
