The instant Execution Application has been filed for seeking enforcement of order dated 09.02.2015 passed by this Court in the main case bearing No.CWP-1648-2013.

Learned counsel for the parties do not dispute that all admissible benefits have already been released in favour of the applicants-petitioners. Leaned counsel for the applicants-petitioners has, however, contends that interest on delayed payments may also be awarded.

He, however, fairly concedes that no interest was awarded to the applicants-petitioners vide order dated 09.02.2015 (supra). In such an eventuality, he also fails to establish that on what basis the prayer of the applicants-petitioners for grant of interest is sustainable.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the applicants-petitioners does not want to press the instant Execution Application any further.

Since all admissible benefits have already been released in favour of the applicants-petitioners, the instant Execution Application is hereby disposed of as fully satisfied.
