1. Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case arising out of FIR No. 15 dated 21.05.2025, registered under Sections 316(2), 85 Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 Police Station Women Cell, Patiala. This is his first petition for anticipatory bail.
2. Vide order dated 05.08.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of DSP Gurvir Singh, PPS, PBI Crime against Women and Children, District Patiala and perusal of para No. 7 of said report shows that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.
4. Considering all relevant facts and circumstances of the case, but without commenting on merits, the petition is allowed and order
