[1] Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.12, dated 27.01.2023, registered under Sections 21 & 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

[2] Vide order dated 20.08.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 20.08.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

[4] Learned State counsel has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

[5] In view of the above, interim order dated 20.08.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) B.N.S.S.
