1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is regarding the non-allotment of station to the petitioner despite her promotion to the post of Lecturer vide order dated 09.09.2023 (Annexure P/1), which is illegal and arbitrary.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the petitioner has already been promoted as Lecturer but the posting order of the petitioner as Lecturer has not been issued to her, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the respondents are liable to be directed to issue posting order of the petitioner as Lecturer to her so that no prejudice is caused to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 23.09.2024 with the

respondents raising the said grievance but the said representation has been closed keeping in view the information received by the petitioner, which is attached with the present petition as Annexure P/4 and no reasons are coming forward for not granting the posting order to the petitioner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents and submits that in case, due reasons, if not already conveyed for rejecting the claim of the petitioner qua her posting as Lecturer, will be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order for their information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in case, the said reasons are incorrect and contrary, a liberty be given to the petitioner to avail an appropriate remedy for the redressal of her grievance.

7. Ordered accordingly.
