**KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)**

Prayer in this petition is for quashing of DDR No.24 dated 07.04.2024 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148, 149 of IPC in FIR No.73 dated 16.06.2023 registered under Sections 323, 427, 148, 149, 341, 506 IPC at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Batala on the basis of compromise.

2. The above stated DDR was registered on the statement of the complainant/respondent No.2-Navtej Singh against the petitioners.

3. On notice of motion, respondent No.2 appeared in the Court through his counsel and pleaded that he has no objection if the DDR in



this case is quashed on the basis of the aforesaid compromise which has been effected between the parties.

4. During the course of preliminary hearing, the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate was directed to record the statements of the all the concerned parties with regard to genuineness and validity or otherwise of the aforesaid compromise.

5. In compliance thereof, report from the Court of Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Batala along with statements of the parties has been received, in which, it is mentioned that the compromise is genuine and there was no undue influence or coercion from any side.

6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioners and for respondent No.2 are *ad idem* that in view of the settlement effected between the parties, the present petition deserves to be accepted. It has also come on record that the aforesaid compromise is genuine and the parties effected the same without any undue influence or coercion.

8. In view of above, nothing remains to be adjudicated further in the present case. Thus, continuation of the criminal proceedings between the parties would be a futile exercise and sheer wastage of time of the Court and thus, amount to abuse of process of law.

9. For the reasons aforestated and having regard to the law laid down by Hon'ble Apex Court in **Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and Five Judges Bench of this

Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, this petition is allowed and DDR No.24 dated 07.04.2024 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148, 149 of IPC in FIR No.73 dated 16.06.2023 registered under Sections 323, 427, 148, 149, 341, 506 IPC at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Batala and all the subsequent proceedings are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
