Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus* for directing respondents No.7 and 8 to decide representation dated 20.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as regards the relief claimed in the instant writ petition, the petitioners have moved a representation dated 20.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) before respondents No.7 and 8, but the same has not been adverted to by the concerned authorities, till date. He submits that petitioners would be satisfied if time bound directions are issued to respondent No.7 (The Executive Engineer, Sirsa)/competent Authority to decide aforesaid representation dated

20.05.2025 (Annexure P-3).

3. Mr. Rajneesh Chadwal, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, appears on behalf of respondents/State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied upon the State. He submits that respondent No.7 (The Executive Engineer, Sirsa)/competent Authority shall take decision either way, on the pending representation dated 20.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners, within a period of four weeks from today.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.7 (The Executive Engineer, Sirsa)/competent Authority, to consider and decide the representation dated 20.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners by way of passing a speaking order; after affording due opportunity of hearing to all the concerned parties, within a period of four weeks from today.

5. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
