1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners for issuance of directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct the investigation in case FIR No.0118 dated 21.04.2025, under Sections 318(4), 316(2) and 61 of BNS, Police Station Kharar, SAS Nagar and also direction to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioners submits that the petitioners have filed a representation dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-2) before the respondent No.2. The learned counsel prays for directions to the respondent No.2 to decide the abovementioned representation within a stipulated time.



3. Notice of motion to the respondents No.1 to 3 only.
4. Mr. Eklavya Darshi, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, and waives service.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a direction for deciding the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-2) be given to the respondent No.2 and that the instant petition be disposed of accordingly.
6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to pass a speaking order and decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-2) within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of instant order. The police authority of District SAS Nagar shall be at liberty to make an independent assessment of the threat perception to the petitioners, and take a decision on the issue of providing security to them. However, it is made clear that there is no observation of this Court with regard to merits of the case and the police authorities shall be at liberty to draw their own conclusion without being influenced by the contents of instant order.
