The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the Superintendent of Police, Panipat to ensure that proper summons are issued to the petitioner specifying the place, date and time for joining the investigation as envisaged under Section 41-A of Cr.P.C.

2. None appears on behalf of the petitioner.
3. The learned counsel for the State while referring to the affidavit dated 23.09.2024 submitted by Rajbir Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Panipat contends that on 14.05.2024, efforts were made to join Dilraj Singh (petitioner) in the case but he could not be found at his house. Therefore, notice was served upon him which was received by his father- Amrik Singh. As per the notice, he was told to appear at the police station on 16.05.2024 at 10.00 a.m. to join the investigation in FIR No. 668

dated 28.09.2022 under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, Police Station City Panipat. However, the petitioner failed to join the investigation but instead has filed the instant petition.

4. A perusal of Para 04 of the reply would also reveal that the petitioner is a serial offender with two other cases i.e. FIR No.119 dated 06.07.2022 under Sections 406, 420 IPC and Sections 10, 24 of the Immigration Act, Police Station Jagadhari, Sadar, District Yamunanagar and FIR No.137 dated 30.07.2022 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, Police Station Jagadhari Sadar, District Yamunanagar, registered against him.

5. In view of the above, I find no merit in the present petition. The same stands dismissed.
