1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 21.07.2023 passed by this court in CWP-15114-2021.

2. The counsel for the petitioner himself has submitted that the order, qua which contempt was asserted, has since been complied with by the respondent. No further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

3. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
