Prayer in the present civil writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus*, seeking a direction to respondent No.3 (Assistant Collector IInd Grade, Indri, District Karnal) to conclude the partition proceedings in case No.101/P/T, instituted on 03.11.2017 (Annexure P-1), in a time bound manner.

2. Ms. Upasana Dhawan, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, appears on behalf of respondents/State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been served upon the State of Haryana.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions, from Mr. Gaurav Kaushik, Naib Tehsildar, Indri, District Karnal, submits that aforesaid partition proceedings pending before learned Assistant Collector IInd Grade, Indri, District Karnal would be concluded within a period of six months

from today, subject to any legal impediment and/or any orders passed by the higher authorities.

Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to learned Assistant Collector IInd Grade, Indri, District Karnal (respondent No.3)/competent authority to conclude the aforesaid partition proceedings, within a period of six months from today, subject to any legal impediment and/or any orders passed by the higher authorities.
