1. In the present petition, the petitioner is praying for releasing his all the retiral benefits alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide his representation dated 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Mr. Ferry Sofat, Advocate, also accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 2 and 3 and both of them do not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-1), within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law. In case, the petitioner is found to be entitled for grant of any benefit as claimed in the representation, the same be released within a period of 8 weeks thereafter.
