**DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)**

By way of this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant suitable employment to the petitioner on compassionate ground.

2. It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that Sh. Pala Ram the father of the petitioner was working as Safai Sewak in Nagar Panchayat, Maloudh, Department of Local Government, Government of Punjab, who expired on 04.02.2021. Under the policy for compassionate appointment (Annexure P-2), petitioner moved an application dated 13.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) for compassionate appointment. However, that application has not been considered till date.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner will be satisfied if his application dated 13.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in the time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Additional AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that he has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.



7. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondents are directed to consider the grievances putforth by the petitioner in application dated 13.12.2022 (Annexure P-3), in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

8. The petition stands disposed of.
