HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J. (ORAL)

CWP No. 4320 of 1996, was disposed of vide order dated 13.09.2013, in terms of the judgment dated 29.09.2006 passed in CWP No. 457 of 1995 titled as '*Prem Singh Gill and others vs. State of Punjab*'. In that case, the respondents had been directed to grant pay scale of Rs. 4125-5600 to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.01.1986 with all consequential benefits. The arrears payable to the petitioners in that writ petition were directed to be calculated and released to them within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

In the reply affidavit filed on behalf of the respondent, it has been stated that in compliance with the order dated 13.09.2013, the arrears were released to the petitioner as detailed in para 6 of the reply.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per the directions of the Court, the arrears were directed to be paid within a period of three months. There is a considerable delay in making the payments. He prays that interest should be directed to be paid on the delayed payment.

It is not disputed that the arrears have since been released and the order has been complied with. Moreover, there was no specific direction in the petition regarding payment of interest, if the payment of arrears is delayed.

Thus, no further order is required to be passed.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule discharged.
