RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.0176, dated 31.05.2025, under Section 25(1-B)(a) of Arms Act and Sections 109(1), 115, 190, 193(3), 324(4) and 351(3) of the BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Sector-5, Gurgaon, Haryana (Annexure P-1).
2. Vide order dated 27.08.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 27.08.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Status report dated 13.10.2025 by way of affidavit of Mukesh Kumar, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Crime-II, Gurugram, has been filed by learned State counsel. Same is taken on record. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manoj Kumar has affirmed the fact that



the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, interim order dated 27.08.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

6. Petition stands allowed.
