Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for quashing letter dated 06.10.2020 (Annexure P-10).

1.1 A further prayer has been made for directing respondents No.5 to 7 to treat application dated 25.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner under Group 1.

1.2 Another prayer has been made for directing respondent No.4 to register the rectified lease deed dated 04.01.2021 (Annexure P-11) and for further commanding respondents No.5 to 7 to consider the rectified lease deed of the petitioner for allotment of the retail outlet.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that inadvertently the petitioner could not lay challenge to the allotment of the retail outlet in favour of respondent No.8, accordingly he prays that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh writ petition on the same cause of action and also for challenging the allotment made in favour of respondent No.8.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

4. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
